Minutes

Parks and Rec committee met on 3 October at 2830 Shelter Island Drive. D. Wylie, C. Conger, C. Shinn, D. Greene. Ann Swanson was introduced. She provided her impressive resume to initiate her desire to work as a committee member. I will present her desire and her resume at our next meeting and ask for a positive vote for inclusion to the Parks and Rec Committee.

Ann brought with her a PENINSULA PARK INVENTORY AND NEEDS ANALYSIS in a manual that she has agreed to share with us. It is a complete history of all the Parks and something she has compiled herself. She was actually Chair of this Committee in the past as well as a former member of the Planning Board. She has spent many hours working and advocating for Parks in Point Loma. Her knowledge will be invaluable as we move forward to projects we hope to spearhead in the future.

Cynthia Conger presented on the Shoreline NTC issue (in Cal Jones absence) and learned that the demolition of the buildings will go forward as the Planning Commission passed the project.

Cydney Shinn reported on the Barnard school project (using 2.5 acres) for a park that already has money funded. She stated that due to low enrollment this year the School Board may decide to close Barnard school. This would be even better as then the current buildings could be renovated into a larger rec Center which is sadly and sorely needed in not only this area but in the entire Pt. Loma area. Need to look into if at least two basket ball courts (inside) could be put there as well as perhaps a free City Pool since none exists now. I learned that one reason we cannot have a Rec Center in the designated Park area is that no new buildings can be placed in the Coastal area (Although new hotels other buildings are going forward as we speak.

Debora Greene will bring us up to date on Collier Park at our next meeting which is the 25th of October, 6PM at 2830 Shelter Island Drive.

Discussion concerning Fiesta Park included the possibility that if developed then Robb Field and Cleator Park could then be used exclusively for Pt Loma rather than as sharing with other communities program that now exists.

We do not have a secretary for this group so in the future I am asking that each person speaking or coming prepared with a prior assignment put it in writing in order to assist in keeping track of #1 the issues, projects and #2 where we are going with them. Putting ideas and reports in writing will also assist in keeping meeting on track.

I would like us to think about a Mission Statement which can then determine our projects and keep our focus more narrowly confined to goals and purposes of this committee.
