

Peninsula Community Planning Board

On the 19th of March the PCPB will elect 5 persons to fill the upcoming vacancies. The term is for 3 years. To be eligible one must be 18 years of age, be a resident or be a property owner within the boundaries indicated in the By Laws. Those are the coastline on the East, Midway on the North and West Point Loma Blvd on the West to Froude St., Froude to Adair, and Sunset Cliffs Coastline to Point Loma Nazarene University and to include the Navy Installation to the South. In addition an applicant must have attended at least one meeting of the PCPB within the past year.

The PCPB has been formed and recognized by the City Council to make recommendations to the City Council, Planning Commission, City Staff and other governmental agencies on land use matters, specifically concerning the preparation of, adoption of, implementation of, or amendment to the General Plan or a land use plan when a plan relates to the Point Loma Community boundaries. The PCPB also advises on other land use issues as requested by the City or other governmental agencies. Prospective candidates can acquaint themselves with the Peninsula Community Plan and the General Plan on line or by visiting in the Planning Department where these manuals are available for perusal. Board members are the eyes and ears of the community for the Planning Department and represent the citizens of Point Loma.

Meetings are the 3rd Thursday of each month unless otherwise notified. They are held at the Point Loma Library Located on Voltaire Street and Poinsettia.
