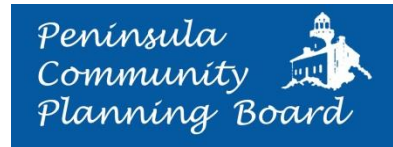

a. Walking Tour of Roseville: KE led a walking tour looping the blocks northwest of Rosecrans. The group viewed and had conversations about the overall lay of the neighborhood.
