PCPB Member Don Sevrens reported that the Wabaska Street sidewalk addition was ongoing. Conrad Wear was assisting in moving the project forward.

The City of San Diego Peninsula Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) are ongoing with some listed projects completed.

Catalina Blvd. road diet may not be feasible, or desirable, due to huge traffic volume from visitors and commuters to the Cabrillo Monument, Fort Rosecrans National Cemetery and Naval operations.

Paul Grimes expressed interest in joining the TTSC. He also presented a written evaluation of his observations of traffic behavior at the corner of Voltaire and Catalina regarding the no right turn on red sign.

Nicole Burgess suggested we formally request that the city prioritize the CIP projects of the Nimitz corridor and the Voltaire/Chatsworth intersection. The intersection of Froude and Voltaire was also identified as a intersection in the need of a continental crosswalk with flashing signal.

Margaret Virissimo had posted on Facebook a request for community input on dangerous streets and had a huge volume of responses. She will consolidate the requests and present next meeting.

Discussion made on various dangerous streets and intersections. Better Buzz Coffee on Rosecrans was noted as a morning traffic condition of concern.

Meeting to be held in November, regarding above Action Items and a continuation of additional CIP requests and dangerous street discussions.
