Mr. Jim Hare presented an overview of the Midway Community Planning Group Draft EIR. The Rosecrans and Nimitz intersection was noted on the Midway EIR as needing additional improvements. Mr. Hare was forwarded the link to the Nimitz/Rosecrans Roadway Improvement website to share with the MCPG. This project may possibly meets the Midway Plan goals for that intersection.

Mr. Hare summarized the The New Midway Plan in which the Midway CPA will be going through significantly transformative changes. Some of the identified areas of involvement were the SPAWAR site on Pacific Highway, the closed Post Office at Barnett/Midway Drive and the Sports Arena. With the pressing need for additional housing and the emphasis on residential infill, these areas have been designated as mixed use sites, an active and engaging blend of residential and commercial uses. Many areas will benefit from a reduced street grid with many new streets created to break up the large inhuman scale parking lots and sites.

The discussion also included Pacific Highway, Barnett, Lytton, and Witherby Street changes and improvements, the need for biking and pedestrian infrastructure additions and safety improvements.

The discussion then became more free flowing and conversational, addressing many planning and traffic issues in our community.
