Access to funds for traffic improvement through our new ad-hoc committee.  
(Developer Impact Fees. DIF)

We will be writing a letter from our committee to the City for the Nimitz Corridor Early Action Bike Project using SB-1 funding to send to the full Board for approval

We had a conversation with Dan Dennison about the recent ad hoc Traffic and Transportation SC for the OBPB. There is no standing TTSC with the OBPB. We discussed the need for better cooperation between our two Boards on our TT issues since we are in the same community. Residents pass through both planning areas with frequency and we could/should be looking at our TT issues together. (Along with the Midway PB too?)

The discussion also included the Nimitz Corridor, the Nimitz and 8 interchange for bike safety, Pacific Highway Corridor changes and improvements, and the need for biking and pedestrian infrastructure additions and safety improvements.

Will continue our requests to the city for improving dangerous intersections.

The discussion then became more free flowing and conversational, addressing many planning, (AirB&B, VRBO) and traffic issues affecting both the Peninsula and Ocean Beach communities.
