April and May Minutes were approved 4-0.

Nicole Burgess reported on the OBPB meeting. The OBPB approved a letter to support a Cycle Track option on W. Point Loma Blvd. between Nimitz Blvd. and Midway Drive.

The PCPB TTSC to forward to the PCPB a letter in support of a bicycle facility, Cycle Track option, on W. Point Loma Blvd. between Nimitz Blvd. and Midway.

Conrad Wear reported that \$300,000 has been budgeted for adaptive controllers at several locations on Rosecrans Street. V-Calming, Flashing Beacons, and Continental Crosswalks were also discussed.

Julie Dillion, La Playa resident has been working to get roundabouts installed on Rosecrans south of Talbot for six years. She announced that the City will be installing roundabouts on Rosecrans St. at Bessemer and at Owen Streets to slow down vehicular traffic and make it safer for resident motorists and pedestrians.

Action Item Letter from the PCPB to support the installation of roundabouts on Rosecrans St. at Bessemer and at Owen Streets and at future additional locations was approved 4-0.

Roundabout and traffic circles were discussed. Ideal locations were suggested. Catalina and Cañon hardscape improvement was discussed.

All-way Stops and accidents were discussed. Ellen McCannon reported accidents at Chatsworth and Browning-changes needed. Other locations and traffic issues were discussed. Possible letter to the City, or SDPD Community Relations Officer David Surwilo to request additional police traffic enforcement.
