Call to order 5:35

2/19/2019 Minutes were approved 2-0.

Committee approved moving Action Items before Discussion Items on the Agenda.

Committee voted to approve and forward to the PCPB a City Letter supporting the removal of the 2-hour parking restriction signs on the north side of Curtis Street between Evergreen St. and Locust St. Todd Setzer spoke and explained the circumstances and desire of the neighbors on Curtis to remove the signs. Vote was 3-0 in favor.

Several intersections in the community have had changes. Stop Signs have been added and Yields have been changed to Stop Signs. There are several intersections noted as having been approved for Flashing Beacons and Continental Crosswalks. These intersections have been added to an Unfunded List and will be upgraded when funds are available. City Staff has been asked how long is this process and the TTSC has not received an answer.

Reverse Diagonal Parking was briefly discussed. It does seem that it is a safer method to park than Head-in Diagonal Parking, but will take time for the populace to become comfortable with the new paradigm.

There was spirited discussion on the community priorities regarding street striping for the bike plan on W. Point Loma Blvd. between Nimitz Blvd. and Midway Drive. The striping is now planned for May/June. Paul Grimes will be meeting with Esmerelda White to further discuss the plans.

An All-way Stop for Cordova and Marseille was discussed. A resident on Cordova had sent an email stating that the intersection has issues with safety. High speeds and poor sight lines were mentioned in a follow-up conversation. The stop does not meet the City guidelines for an All-way Stop. The resident will be following up with neighbors regarding consensus on installation.
