Non-agenda public comment:

Joe Battaglia expressed frustration with the a dangerous condition on the sidewalk on the West side of Nimitz, North of Lowell St. Vegetation is covering the sidewalk which is forcing students and pedestrians to step onto the street. Joe stated the City told him that the owners of the properties above the sidewalk are responsible for not maintaining their property.

Jesse Benson said that the crosswalk at the Northbound Nimitz on-ramp at Famosa Blvd. is dangerous at night. He suggested that the street light at the SW corner of the bridge be modified to illuminate the intersection.

Committee approved moving Action Items before Discussion Items on the Agenda.

Committee voted 7-0 to approve and forward to the PCPB support for the Parking Time Limit Zone Petition submitted by Bobbie Dion. The petition is requesting that the City determine whether the existing 2 hour parking limit zone from the 400-450 block of San Antonio Ave. is appropriate for the location. Time limit is enforced, M-F, 8:00am-2:00pm.

Discussion of the 2010 Pt. Loma Cluster School Foundation Traffic Safety Committee's requested improvements at five local elementary schools. Discussion tabled in order for members to have additional time to familiarize themselves with the the requests. The Committee will then compare the present conditions with the 2010 requested improvements in order to determine what additional improvements are needed for completion.
