RE: Froude and Voltaire Street

Safety is one of the greatest concerns for the residents and we thank the City for supporting Vision Zero and implementing safer pedestrian and bicycling facilities throughout the City.

The intersection at Voltaire and Froude is one of the most dangerous intersections in our community. Residents attempting to cross Voltaire St. at Froude are unable to see automobiles traveling downhill on Voltaire due to the blind corner. This condition and the width of the street puts pedestrians, bicyclist and motorist attempting to cross the intersection in danger of being struck by cars.

The Peninsula Community Planning Board would like to request that the City analyze this intersection for traffic calming measures and implement changes to improve the safety for pedestrians, bicyclist and motorists.
