

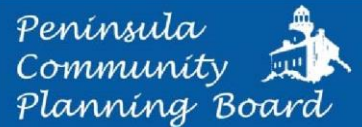

2. Action Items

- a. Approve designation of Bicycle Blvd as a community plan amendment. The bicycle Blvd would connect Liberty Station from Laning to Rosecrans west, right on Poe St, left on Locust to Nimitz Blvd. These streets are in very poor condition so should be considered for resurfacing and at that time, it is recommended that traffic calming, signage and street marking improvements be made to support safe walking and biking in the area. Optional consideration is to make right onto Newell from Locust and a left onto Evergreen to Nimitz. Space would need to be created through bushes with proper access, but this could be as a longer vision for improving this intersection as Evergreen to the west has been reclassified to a Bicycle Blvd already and would be the direct access.
- b. Liberty Station - streets are being resurfaced due to contractor issues on its last slurry seal. Discussion to see if there is an opportunity to request street markings and/or bicycle facilities on these streets.
