Matt motioned to modify the agenda and switch items A and B on the list. Mandy seconds the motion. Motion passes unanimously.

Non-Agenda Public Comment

Margaret shared information on the "Ride the Point" event.

Action Items

1. Update and discussion on the Froude corridor from Voltaire to Newport. Discuss alternate traffic safety mitigations available to calm the traffic along Froude.

Mandy shares the Rode Hump evaluation form with the subcommittee and asks if there are any other traffic mitigations other than stop signs that the community is asking the city for, such as diverters, stripping, and installation of advisory lanes, and requesting a traffic and transportation speed study along the stretch.

Nicole asks for the consideration of advocating for a bike advisory lane so that the bikers have a safer place to ride.

Paul is concerned that there will be no bike lanes, and Matt clarifies that advisory lanes are different from traditional full bike lanes.

Matt suggests adding the present community member's concerns within the letter.

Nicole makes a motion to construct a letter with the above requests. Mandy seconds the motion. The motion passes 7 to 0.

The community members' concerns will be added to the letter.

2. Letter requesting Safe pedestrian facilities on Catalina & Santa Barbara & Hill Streets.

Nicole clarifies this is an unsafe passage for not only pedestrians but also vehicles.

Mandy wonders if installing bike lanes would be a beneficial traffic calming issue. Nicole does not believe it would be appropriate traffic mitigation.

Mandy suggests requesting that the city evaluate the area and install the appropriate traffic mitigations.

Margaret suggests writing a letter.

Mandy will make a formal request to the city so there is a reference to refer to in the future and history of advocating for the area.

Robert suggests asking for police reports on incidents in the area.

Mandy makes a motion to request a letter be sent to the city to request a traffic study to evaluate this intersection and ask that they provide the PCPB with their traffic mitigation proposals to allow the PCPB the opportunity to request community input. Tina seconds the motion. Motion passes 6 to 0.

3. Review the intersection of Nimitz and West Point Loma Boulevard and the connecting corridors to request traffic calming measures and/or a traffic study of the area.

Matt makes a recommendation to revisit requesting a speed study. Ideally, he would like to see protected bike lanes.

Mandy suggests requesting protected bike lanes.

Mandy will add an action item to request a traffic study and states that the letter should include this request as well as a request for bike lanes within the same letter.

Matt makes a motion to include three parts in the letter recommendations: follow through on West Point Loma completion, Nimitz completion, and fix this corridor in question with protected bike infrastructure. This will increase connectivity within the community. Mandy seconds this motion. Motion passes unanimously with a vote of 6 to 0.

4. Review the intersection of Rosecrans and Dickens to request traffic calming measures and/or a traffic study of the area.

Matt suggests some of the mitigations on Scott street may be applicable here.

Mandy makes a motion to table this item for a future meeting. Robert seconds the motion. Motion passes unanimously, 6 to 0.

Informational Items / Discussion

1. Discussion about proposed 2-hour parking along SSC's Boulevard and no parking in the early morning hours. This is a request that has been made to the city by residents.

Mandy shares the proposed requests for Sunset Cliffs.

Mandy will bring his discussion as an action item to make recommendations at the next meeting,

2. Discuss and review the existing list of traffic and transportation items of interest to determine status and the best course of action.

Mandy makes a motion to table this for the next meeting. Tina seconds this motion. Motion passes unanimously.
