RE: Letter requesting the reduction of speed and for road humps be installed along the frontage

road of 1600 Chatsworth Road adjacent and south of Chatsworth Road

Due to increased urgency in traffic safety concerns and safety of children walking to and from school as communicated from community members who live along Chatsworth frontage road adjacent to and south of Chatsworth, the Peninsula Community Planning Board (PCPB) is requesting that the City of San Diego Traffic and Transportation department fund a traffic safety study to identify traffic safety mitigations and calming measures. In particular, the street residents request the installation of speed humps on Chatsworth frontage road.

Chatsworth frontage road is adjacent to and south of Chatsworth Road extending for approximately two blocks.

Specifically local community members have observed cars travel at excessive speeds especially when children are transiting from school in the afternoons. When traffic backs up on Chatsworth Road in the afternoons, commuters will use the Chatsworth frontage road to bypass traffic.

The letter was approved unanimously with a vote of 12-0.
