Objectives

- Cooperate, communicate and collaborate with any and all public agencies, community groups, and/or private entities engaged in seeking new location(s) for a commercial air service airport for the San Diego region
- Serve as a liaison between the Peninsula Community Planning Board (PCPB), the Peninsula community and the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority (SDCRAA) with particular emphasis on concerns regarding safety and noise impacts
- Serve as the PCPB's representatives at SDCRAA meetings, including Authority Board, Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC), Airport Advisory Commission, Airport Noise Advisory Committee and Regional Aviation Strategic Plan meetings regarding current and future airport activities
- Communicate information regarding SDCRAA initiatives to the PCPB accurately and in a timely basis
- Provide policy guidance to the PCPB for PCPB approval regarding all airport initiatives as necessary
- Cooperate, communicate and collaborate with any and all public agencies, community groups, and/or private entities engaged in seeking new location(s) for a commercial air service airport for the San Diego region
- Monitor SDCRAA's Quieter Home Program to provide residential sound insulation to qualifying residences as quickly as possible
- Promote public outreach on airport related matters
