**Question #1:** Can the City evaluate the conversional signals identified in Project No. M-4, Peninsula Traffic Signal Modifications, to determine if additional traffic signals can be added to the adaptive traffic controller section?

The following conversion signals have been completed and will be removed from the Fiscal Year 2019 Peninsula Impact Fee Study (Peninsula IFS): Numbers 19, 20, and 23.

The City will add the following conversion signals to the adaptive traffic controllers list: Numbers 17, 21, and 22.

**Question #2:** Can the 3000 block and 3100 block be replaced with the limits for Talbot Street (#3) for Project No. M-7, Peninsula Traffic Calming?

Yes.

The City will remove the block numbers and added the limits for Talbot Street.

**Question #3:** Can the five roundabouts included in Project No. M-10, Peninsula Roundabouts, be revised to the below locations?

**Question #4:** Can the Ocean Beach Life Guard Tower, Fiscal Year 2015 Ocean Beach Public Facilities Financing Plan Project No. F-2, be added to the Peninsula IFS?

Yes.

An additional Fire-Rescue project will be added to the Peninsula IFS.

**Question #5:** Can “safety improvements on Canon Street and Catalina Boulevard” be added to the Peninsula IFS?

Yes.

The City will add roundabout Number 1 to Project No. M-10, Peninsula Roundabouts.

- City will revise the Fiscal Year 2019 Peninsula Impact Fee Study to incorporate the above changes
