Re: Nimitz Blvd./Sunset Cliffs Blvd./Interstate-8 terminus-Bicycle Striping Improvements

The Nimitz Blvd., Sunset Cliffs Blvd. and Interstate 8 terminus intersections are extremely dangerous for bicyclists to safely cross and maneuver due to the high speed vehicular traffic at those locations. These interwoven intersections are major links, connecting bicycle routes from Point Loma and Ocean Beach to destinations north.

The Peninsula Community Planning Board requests that Caltrans and the City of San Diego apply NACTO paint treatments at the Nimitz Blvd./Sunset Cliffs Blvd. / Interstate-8 intersections. The paint treatments will temporarily create safer conditions at these intersections to navigate on bicycles until safer facilities are designed in the future.
