RE: PCPB Elections Notification

This letter serves as notification of the PCPB elections for publication in **public and social media**, and posting on the **PCPB website** (www.pcpb.net).

The Peninsula Community Planning Board (PCPB) will be holding elections in March 2018 to fill five (5) vacancies. Board terms are three (3) years, with exception of unexpired terms which are filled.

Requirements for those interested in becoming a Board Member:

- Candidates must be 18 years of age.
- Candidates must reside, own property, or operate a business within the PCPB boundaries (boundaries map provided at www.pcpb.net).
- Candidates must have attended one regular PCPB meeting within the previous 12-month term. Attending the candidates forum qualifies for this requirement.

The election will be held on Thursday, March 15, 2018 from 4:00pm – 8:00pm, at the Point Loma / Hervey Branch Library located at 3701 Voltaire Street, San Diego, CA 92107. Proof of residence, business operation, or property ownership within the PCPB boundaries must be provided for an individual to vote.

The candidates' forum will be held on Thursday, March 1, 2018, from 5:30pm - 7:00pm, at the Point Loma / Hervey Branch Library located at 3701 Voltaire Street, San Diego, CA 92107.

The deadline to qualify for candidacy in the March general election shall be on or prior to the Candidates Forum.
