I have been a resident for 26 years and raised my children in this community. I have lived in SD since 1970 when my father was stationed here for the Navy.

I serve on the board of Alpha Project for the Homeless for 15 years and I am on the advisory board for the San Diego Center for Center, the oldest non-profit in SD serving families, children and adolescent suffering from behavioral and mental challenges. Serving these two boards allow me to be informed on legislative issues that these organizations need to manage in order to serve this population. I am also involved with Malin Burnham's scholarship program at USD and Cal State. I regularly attend the monthly SD Military Council meetings in Pt. Loma to keep abreast of the military challenges in SD and projects that are in development. The Navy contributes ¼ of the revenue to the state budget and are growing by 5,000 personnel in SD which is vital to be aware of when serving on this board as many military personnel live in PT and OB.

Share your special interests, expertise or philosophy as it relates to the Peninsula Community: I have been involved in feeding approx.. 100 homeless in OB through my church for over 12 years-funding, cooking and serving- 2000-2012. I am a believer of providing safe housing for all community members-homeless, affordable, missing middle are crucial for a vibrant community which we lack in SD at the moment. I believe in collaboration and striving for a common goal that is inclusive and done with compassion. This can only be accomplished by educating yourself with facts on issues that are needing attention.
