Non-Agenda Public Comment

Mark Onsurez is a community member living in the Oleander drive area. He states that the streetlights are not working, and the street is dark at night. He has submitted over 100 reports to the "Get it Done" service and has not received any information on the schedule of improvements.

ACTION ITEMS

a. Letter requesting installation of No Parking from 10 pm- 5 am Signs along SSC's Boulevard and striping to be expanded along with the turn from SSC's to Ladera to allow for more space for emergency response vehicles to turn the corner without going over the double yellow line.

Request the city to expand Red Striping at drain along SSC in between Monaco and Ladera to promote visibility. Request the city to establish permit parking for the neighborhood residents.

Community member Glen speaks about the issues that residents are experiencing in the Sunset Cliffs area at night. He shares this is not a homelessness issue but rather about people parking their vans on Sunset Cliffs Blvd. as an overnight car camping spot.

Another concern is people partying along Sunset Cliffs Blvd. during the night and the early morning hours.

This is all related to the lack of law enforcement within Sunset cliffs.

Mandy shares some possible solutions that could bring about a remedy. A map shows an area with red dots, which would be the locations of signs with the municipal codes to remind people of the rules and regulations in the area.

Mandy would like to see the city review permit parking for this area. This would give the neighbors another tool to enforce parking on the street.

Mandy suggests limiting the parking from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Robert states that permit parking might be daunting due to the requirement of gaining signatures.

Angela suggests pushing back the park closure time.

Dalana, a community member, states that she would like to see high support for law enforcement along the cliffs.

Matt mentions simplifying the mitigations to combat two problems; the location of parked vehicles and the problem of people dumping waste down the drains.

Glen thinks that permit parking mitigations would not be appropriate for the situation in Sunset Cliffs, and the rest of the subcommittee members agree.

Dalana emphasizes that law enforcement should be the primary mitigation.

Nicole suggests matching the requests with OB planning for a dual effort.

Mandy makes a motion to request more enforcement in the area due to the long ongoing problems that the tenants are experiencing in the area. The motion includes a request to install red paint striping of up to 30ft on each side on the corner of Sunset Cliffs and Ladera to allow for emergency vehicles to make the turn when maneuvering the area, as well as to expand the striping near the fire hydrant and storm drain in between Carmelo and Ladera to promote the visibility of the area due to illegal dumping of sewage in the storm drain. Lastly, to request the installation of street signs stating no parking from 10 pm to 4 am along Sunset Cliffs Blvd, starting at Adair and along both sides of Ladera, as well as Cordova, Devonshire, and Amiford and all streets that are adjacent to sunset cliffs park.

These requests will come in a letter sent to the mayor, the city council member for this district, Gary Pence, and the western division.

Mandy asks the subcommittee if it would be appropriate to ask for additional funding for peace officers to enforce the area. Mandy will add this to the motion.

Matt suggests restricting the initial request to Sunset Cliffs Blvd rather than including other streets in the request. Margaret and Angela second this request.

Dalana agrees with Matt on this request.

Mandy amends the motion to restrict the requests to Sunset Cliffs Blvd and Ladera. The motion is to request to install street signs stating "no parking from 10 pm to 4 am" ending at both sides of Ladera, as well as to stripe with red paint the corner of Ladera and the storm drain, as well as to request more enforcement of the area continually, and to request additional funding for peace officers to monitor the Sunset Cliffs area.

Margaret seconds the motion. The motion passes by a unanimous vote.

This will be presented to the mainboard for consideration.

b. Review and recommend possible traffic safety mitigations in the vicinity of North Harbor Drive, in between Scott Street and Nimitz Blvd.

There is an issue of traffic safety as there have been two recent incidents of pedestrians being hit by cars.

Mandy makes a motion to table this discussion for the next meeting. Angela seconds the motion. The motion passes unanimously.

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

a. Discuss and review existing list of traffic and transportation items of interest to determine status and best course of action.

Mandy makes a motion to move the informational item to another meeting. Dalana seconds the motion. Motion passes unanimously.
