**Subject: Receive Community and Board input for FY 2025-2026
Capital Improvement Project Priorities for consideration by the City of San Diego and City Council for
the Point Loma Community.**

The Peninsula Community Planning Board (PCPB) is seeking community input for capital improvement projects that will enhance the community and improve local infrastructure. Public input is important to understand the desired need for additional public infrastructure as well as community priorities. The City has developed a process to solicit public input on infrastructure needs and priorities thru [Council Policy 000-32: Neighborhood Input on Infrastructure Needs and Priorities](#) and/or the [Infrastructure Prioritization Engagement City Website](#) where you can submit your suggestions.

The Long Range Planning Committee of the PCPB has initiated a list of projects for consideration that will enhance safety and provide infrastructure to create a more livable community. The proposed projects are consistent with the Peninsula Community Plan. Several of the projects are in the early stages of development, require funding, and continued community and city council support.

At the July 18 PCPB meeting, the Board is seeking additional input, comments, and projects to forward to the City of San Diego and City Council for consideration in the FY 2025-26 CIP program process.

- **Chatsworth Blvd RRFB & Pedestrian Refuge Island & Ped Refuge Island, Project ID # B21117.** Project consists of a safe crossing across Chatsworth Blvd. to Plumosa Park. Installation of a pedestrian refuge island/median, curb extension, and rapid flash beacons. Advertise and Award construction as design is scheduled to finish in FY 2024.
- **NTC Aquatic Center ID Project ID #L23002.** Complete feasibility design studies to construct a 50-meter competition pool, 25 meter recreational pool, and leisure pool with playground features. Receive community input, complete design and fund construction.
- **Street Light Repairs in Loma Portal.** The historical lights in Loma Portal including those on Goldsmith, Locust, and Evergreen Streets need repair. Maintain the historical significance of the lights and increase funding for an on-going maintenance repair project and/or CIP project.
- **Sunset Cliffs Seawall Improvements Project ID #S23006.** Expedite funding and design for improvements and maintenance to preserve and protect Sunset Cliffs Blvd and the linear section along the shoreline. Sinkholes and erosion issues must be addressed.
- **Cabrillo Recreation Center Improvements.** Cabrillo Recreation Center is the sole recreation center for the community. Provide a feasibility study to enhance and improve recreational opportunities for the community, including after school programs and additional pickleball courts.
