ACTION ITEMS

1. Approval of November 12, 2024 Meeting Minutes.

3. Discussed speed check on the stretch of Famosa Blvd past the Nimitz Blvd Bridge towards Valeta Blvd, follow up item if needed.

- Gary Pence/Flavia DePlachett with City of San Diego office set up speed checks during the weekday - Wednesday to capture the traffic.
- Flavia DePlachett suggested signs for 25 mph for school zone. Follow email sent to her to get a better understanding of the study.

4. Discussed Nimitz and Chatsworth. Speed limit signs. 45MPH sign is in effect for traffic going toward the bay on EB Nimitz.

- There is a weaving section and probably should be reduced to 40MPH, which is the speed limit east of Chatsworth.
- After consideration by the committee, pause letters, asking the city to first conduct studies.

5. Discussed West Point Loma and Nimitz accidents - Mandy Havlik and Angela Vedder

- Speed racing, what police can do to prevent it in the area. This is being combined with item number 4 above.
- After consideration by the committee, pause letters, asking the city to first conduct studies.

6. Discussed Oleander Dr/Pl news article and neighbor communications.

- Request to re-review and prioritize Oleander Drive and Oleander Place road conditions - Letter for Approval by the PCPB.
- Motion to approve letter to the PCPB board from Angela Vedder and seconded from Cori Salcido, approved. 4-0. Letter was emailed to all subcommittee members for review and input prior to sending to the board. It was approved by all 5-0 to include Mandy Havlik. It will be presented at the March 20th meeting.
