This letter serves as notification of the PCPB elections for publication in public and social media, and posting on the PCPB website (www.pcpb.net).

The Peninsula Community Planning Board (PCPB) will be holding elections in March 2026 to fill five (5) vacancies. Each of the Five (5) seats have 5 year terms and Two (2) seats for a 1 year term go to the 7 candidates with the most votes.

Requirements for those interested in becoming a Board Member:

- Candidates must be 18 years of age.
- Candidates must reside, own property, or operate a business within the PCPB boundaries (boundaries map provided at www.pcpb.net).
- Candidates must have attended one regular PCPB meeting within the previous 12-month term. Attending the candidates' forum qualifies for this requirement. The election will be held on Thursday, March 19, 2026 from 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm, at the Point Loma / Hervey Branch Library located at 3701 Voltaire Street, San Diego, CA 92107. Each voter must appear in person with proof of residence, business operation, or property ownership within the PCPB boundaries to vote.

Mail-in or Proxy voting is not allowed.

The candidates' forum will be held on Thursday, March 12, 2026, from 6:00 pm - 7:00 pm, in the Point Loma/Hervey Branch Library located at 3701 Voltaire Street, Ca 92107.
